The Bay County Chevron Fuel Your School Teacher Award Contest Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. OPEN TO TEACHERS WHO ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT TIME OF ENTRY AND EMPLOYED IN THE BAY COUNTY, PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT. CONTEST IS VOID OUTSIDE OF BAY COUNTY, PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA.

These are the Official Rules that govern the Bay County Chevron Fuel Your School Teacher Award Contest (the "Contest"). Chevron Products Company, a division of Chevron U.S.A. Inc. is the "Sponsor" and "Administrator" of the Contest. The Bay County Chamber of Commerce will act as the panel of judges.

Contest Entry Period: The entry period for the contest starts on October 15, 2019 and ends on August 1, 2020 (the "Entry Period"). The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law. By participating, you agree to these Official Rules and to all decisions of the Sponsor/Administrator which are final and binding in all respects.

Participant Eligibility: The Contest is open to all full-time educators at a K-12 public school employed by a public school district located in Bay County, Panama City, Florida who are 18 years of age or older at time of entry, spend at least seventy-five percent (75%) of their time working directly with students not in an administrative capacity, and have a DonorsChoose.org account for posting project requests. If a participant does not have an existing DonorsChoose.org account, they may request an account at www.donorschoose.org/teacher. Employees, contractors, directors and officers of Sponsor/Administrator, or any of their subsidiaries, divisions, affiliates, parent companies, retail locations, suppliers, distributors, contest material suppliers, promotion or media partners, printers of contest materials, advertising, promotion or any other agencies or entities involved with the promotion (collectively, the "Contest Entities") and members of their immediate families (including spouses, parents, grandparents, children, siblings or spouse of any of the foregoing; biological, step or in-law) or households of any of the above, whether related or not, are NOT eligible to participate in this Contest.

How To Enter: Post a project on DonorsChoose.org during the Contest Entry Period. Projects will be selected by a panel of judges and based on the below judging criteria in STEAM Elements (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math). There is a limit of one entry per eligible participant for the Contest. Sponsor/Administrator is not responsible for entries that are lost, late, delayed, damaged, incomplete, misdirected or not received for any reason.

Selecting the Teacher Project of the Month – Monthly Awards

- There are a total of ten (10) awards available during the Contest. One (1) award for \$500 in DonorsChoose.org gift cards to help fund the project will be given per month, with a total of \$5,000 available in DonorsChoose.org gift cards for project funding in the Contest.
- The Bay County Chamber of Commerce Education Committee will act as the panel of judges and review all eligible projects posted on DonorsChoose.org on or about the 15th of each month during the Entry Period to select the Teacher Project of the Month. The first monthly winner will be selected on or about November 1, 2019 and each subsequent monthly winner will be selected on or about the first of the month during the Contest.
- Winners will be notified during the week following selection and presented with their \$500 in DonorsChoose.org gift cards by the Bay County Chamber of Commerce and Chevron during an award ceremony each month.

Entries should include STEAM Elements (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math), and other criteria. The panel of judges will use the following criteria to select each monthly award:

Announcement of Monthly Awards:

- a. One project will be selected per month with a total of 10 projects chosen.
- b. The school's principal will be contacted to verify the eligibility of the Teacher Project of the Month Award winner and the recognition at a Chamber of Commerce Member breakfast meeting.
- c. Each Teacher Project of the Month Award winner will receive a Certificate of Recognition and invitation to attend the breakfast to be recognized.

All decisions of the Bay County Chamber of Commerce and Chevron are final and binding. If any winner is found not to be eligible or not in compliance with these Official Rules or cannot be contacted or is unable to accept the prize for any other reason, Sponsor/Administrator may, in their sole discretion, disqualify the participant and award that prize to the next highest scored entry in the Contest. Publicity: Except where prohibited participation in this Contest constitutes winners consent to the Contest's Entities' unqualified and unconditional use of any winner's name, likeness, photograph, voice, opinions, entry photograph and/or hometown and state for promotional purposes in any media, worldwide, without further payment or consideration.

General Conditions: Sponsor/Administrator reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify these Official Rules, the Contest, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond Sponsor/Administrator's reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Contest, as determined by Sponsor/Administrator in its sole discretion. Sponsor/Administrator reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual for any reason, including but not limited to those it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, Sponsor/Administrator reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor/Administrator's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. In the event that the Contest is canceled or discontinued for any reason, Sponsor/Administrator reserves the right to select winners from among all eligible entries received before the cancellation or discontinuation of the Contest.
