- Deadline for application submission is Friday, August 4, 2023, by 4 p.m.
- Applicants will be notified by August 31, 2023.

The Leadership Bay orientation luncheon will be held on Wednesday, September 27 at 11:30. This meeting will be the first opportunity to meet your fellow classmates and the steering committee. You will also receive your nametag, notebooks, procedures, etc. **Attendance is mandatory for the Orientation Luncheon on September 27, 2-Day – Retreat on October 5-6, and First Friday on June 7.**

Tuition is \$1000.00 for Chamber members, and for future members, \$1375.00. Payment is due within 10 days of acceptance into the program. If tuition is not received by this date, you may be dropped from the class.

Program Commitment for the Class of 2023-2024

The mission of Leadership Bay is to cultivate a broadened network of well-informed leaders whose strengthened commitment to community involvement will affect positive change in Bay County. An applicant’s willingness to invest the time required for active participation in the program is an absolute prerequisite to selection. The signed Program Commitment must be uploaded to the application.

- Attendance is required at the following events and sessions (subject to the make-up policy) for graduation from Leadership Bay. The typical sessions run from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Dates and session topics are subject to change.)
- Participants are required to attend one county commission meeting before January 2024.
- Participants are required to join a Bay County Chamber committee or task force (your choice) if are not already serving. This requirement must be fulfilled by January 2024.
- In addition, besides attending the sessions below, participants must take an active role in the Class Project. This will require time commitment outside of scheduled sessions. Completion of the Class Project is mandatory for graduation.
